### **BULKY DAYS AT THE TRANSFER STATION**

Bulky Days at the Transfer Station for Town of Keene residents will be held on October 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. **This disposal project is for Town of Keene homeowners and renters only.** Commercial operations and Town of Jay residents will not be allowed to bring material during this period. Garbage, recyclables and scrap metal will be handled as usual. No C & D materials, paints or hazardous materials will be accepted. Sleeper sofas and recliners should have metal frames removed when possible. Refrigerators, humidifiers and air conditioners will be accepted at no charge for disposal; however, the Freon removal charge is \$20. Other items at no charge are mattresses, furniture, beds, computers, old clothing, linoleum, carpeting, toilets, picnic benches, etc. Full pick-up truck loads will be charged \$5. Tires will be accepted at regular charge.

### **TOWN SPONSORED SHOPPING BUS**

The Town of Keene shopping bus is scheduled to go to Plattsburgh on Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup>. The round trip fee for this service is \$10.00 per rider, depending on how many riders sign up (\$40.00 must be reached).
