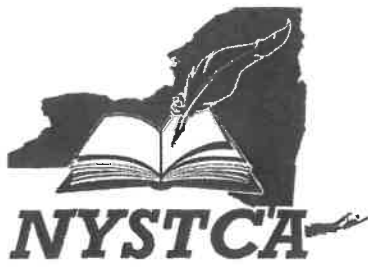

LOCAL LAW # _____ 2023

ESTABLISHING DATE FOR MEETING OF BOARD OF ASSESSMENT REVIEW

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to establish a date for meetings of the Board of Assessment Review pursuant to Real Property Tax Law §512 other than beginning on the fourth Tuesday of May.

SECTION 2: DATE FOR MEETING OF BOARD OF ASSESSMENT REVIEW

a. Beginning on the fourth Tuesday in May and no later than the second Tuesday of June, the Board of Assessment Review may establish a date, and so many days thereafter as the Board of Assessment Review deems necessary, such Board shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

b. Notice of the time and place of such hearing described herein shall be published once on or before the fourth Tuesday in April, in a newspaper circulating in the Town of Keene and affixed in the Town Hall located at 10892 NYS Route 9N, Keene, New York.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State and with the State Board of Equalization and Assessment.

SECTION 4: REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT LOCAL LAWS OR ORDINANCES:

a. This Local Law shall supersede all prior inconsistent Local Laws, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations relative to a date for establishing a meeting of the Board of Assessment Review within the Town of Keene.

b. All prior inconsistent Local Laws, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to Local Law ___ of 2010, and upon the effectiveness of this Local Law, are hereby repealed.
