Contractor to purchase and install the following or equal items in the town hall

- 1. 4 ton, 48000 BTU LG or equal heat pump with 3 linesets and interior heads:
 - a. 1 located in the town court room
 - b. A second head located in the main area of the town hall
 - c. A third head in the back offices of the town hall
 - d. A fourth set left for future use
- 2. Current furnace and all existing forced air trunks to be removed and disposed of. 275 gallon fuel tank to be removed from basement and properly disposed of.
- 3. Purchase and install new LP furnace with humidifier in basement of town hall and install baseboard heat. Sized to provide appropriate supplement to heat pumps.
- 4. Suggested to inspect town hall prior to submitting. Please call to schedule a time.

The Town of Keene retains the right to accept or reject any or all bids. Proposals will be evaluated on both cost and the ability to complete the installation in a timely manner.
